

# Police Fire On Rioters In Bulawayo

**BULAWAYO.** Southern Rhodesia — Police fired on African rioters in a Negro section of Bulawayo today, killing at least one Negro as rioting against white rule continued for the third day.

Thousands of workers in the city's native labor force failed to show up for work. Police said Negro mobs were swarming around the city's railroad marshalling yards. Two other groups were blocked by authorities as they tried to invade the white sector.

**THREE KILLED** — At least three Negroes already had been killed and more than 70 injured in outbreaks Sunday and Monday. Rioting continued unchecked Monday night as the Negro section. More than 1,000 troops sealed off the African townships.

Many of Bulawayo's 45,000 whites locked themselves in their homes, fearing that the government would use force to suppress the riot. Some two to three miles from the center town, but were forced to withdraw after pitched battles.
